
**Recommended Motion:** To approve the appointment of Betty McLane-Iles to fill an unexpired term on the Historic Preservation Commission.

**Background:** The Historic Preservation Commission was created by Ordinance of the City Council on February 23, 2009. Sandy Slocum recently resigned from the Commission, therefore creating a vacant position. Betty McLane-Iles was appointed last May to the Planning and Zoning Commission, and a representative of the Planning and Zoning Commission serves on the Historic Preservation. Mrs. McLane-Iles is interested to fill the current vacancy on this Commission, with a term expiring February 2013.

The Commission's mission is to protect and preserve places, areas and neighborhoods of historical and cultural importance within the city limits for the promotion of its economic development.
