2021 RECYCLING AND GLASS COLLECTION CALENDAR



Glass Collection

To register for the glass program, residents must contact the City of Kirksville to sign up and pay for the tote by the 25th of the prior month.

- Glass is collected on the 1st Monday of each month.
- Tote must be curbside by 6:30 a.m.

Recycling Collection

RTS North LLC. Provides one 65-gallon cart for collection of recyclables. Additional recycling items may be placed in clear bags for collection.

Collection is **EVERY OTHER WEEK.**

- Carts Must be curbside by 6:30 a.m. on your scheduled day of garbage collection.
- All recyclables must be clean of **ALL** food waste and other debris.
- Cardboard & newspapers should be bundled.
- Shredded paper must be bagged separately for collection.

ACCEPTABLE ITEMS INCLUDE: Plastics #1 & #2, Aluminum Cans, Steel Cans, Paper, Corrugated Cardboard.

NOT ACCEPTED ITEMS INCLUDE: Plastics #3-#7, Styrofoam, Glass (taken with the Glass program only), Diapers, Paper Towels, Paper Plates, Pizza Boxes, etc.

- In the event recycling is not curbside at time of collection or recyclables contain items that are not accepted, the resident must make proper corrections for items to be collected on the next scheduled recycling day.
