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KIRKSVILLE REGIONAL AIRPORT WELCOMES NEW AIRLINE

Passengers traveling on Missouri's newest regional air carrier, Cape Air, can now book their entire trip, to and from Kirksville, on-line with Cape Air and American Airlines.

"You can plan your getaways for work or pleasure and book your entire travel itinerary at one website," says Cape Air's Vice-President of Planning, Andrew Bonney. "The Cape Air codeshare with American Airlines gives Kirksville passengers seamless connections with one click for ticket and boarding passes along with convenient baggage transfers to your final destination."



Cape Air offers three daily round trips between Kirksville and St. Louis with a flight time of about an hour. Fares between Kirksville and St. Louis are \$49 each way including all taxes and fees and are available at <http://www.capeair.com>. 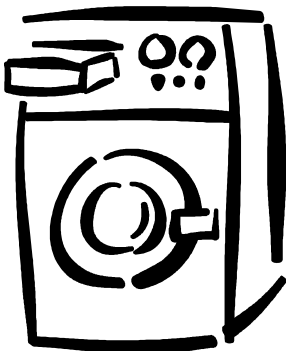

FALL APPLIANCE PICK UP SCHEDULED



The City of Kirksville is offering the opportunity for residents to dispose of household appliances free of charge, regardless of whether it contains Freon. The actual pick up of appliances will be done by Perfect Metals USA LLC during the week of November 8-12. Household appliances that will be eligible for pick up include: Refrigerators, Freezers, Stoves, Ovens, Air Conditioning Units, Washers, Dryers, Dishwashers, Microwaves, Toasters, Furnaces, Hot Water Heaters and Space Heaters.

Citizens should call Perfect Metals USA LLC at 660-665-8000, or 660-651-0290, to schedule a pick up for their appliances during the week of November 8-12.

WHAT IS PROPOSITION A?

Proposition A, on the November 2nd ballot, calls for a statewide vote on the repeal of a one percent earnings tax currently in place in St. Louis and Kansas City. That means all voters, including those of us in Kirksville and Northeast Missouri, could decide how those municipalities make their funding decisions. The Kirksville City Council is not in favor of this measure and here is why:

For those who live in Kansas City or St. Louis, this means everybody in the state will have a vote on whether those cities are required to put the earnings tax up for a vote every five years. If a municipality's voters ever decide to repeal the tax, it will be phased out over ten years and never allowed to be reinstated.

Why should the citizens of Kirksville care? Proposition A, if approved, would prevent any municipality, including Kirksville, to ever consider an earnings tax to fund services. Do we want everybody outside our Kirksville area voting on our right to decide how we pay for government services?

St. Louis and Kansas City depend on their earnings taxes for 33 percent and 42 percent of their general revenue, respectively. From this revenue, those cities fund police and fire departments, street maintenance, snow removal, garbage collection and other fundamental services that are critical to the quality of life of their residents and workers in those cities. Proposition A does not specify a substitute means of paying for those basic services.

The earnings tax was put into place in St. Louis and Kansas City shortly after World War II, as veterans and their families moved to the suburbs, but continued to commute to the cities for their jobs. The tax was a way to fairly distribute the costs of providing services among everyone who uses them on a regular basis. This system has worked for more than 60 years.

One person, a billionaire based in St. Louis named Rex Sinquefeld, is spearheading and significantly funding this ballot initiative effort. Mr. Sinquefeld has made it publicly known that this is the first step in a series of plans to change how the state and its municipalities fund public systems and services. This one person could take away the privileges that all Missouri cities, including our community, currently enjoy if Proposition A should pass.

All Missouri registered voters will have the opportunity to vote NO on Proposition A at the November 2nd polls. We ask that Kirksville residents be well informed voters when going to the polls on November 2nd.
