EMERGENCY PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, COVID-19 is a novel acute respiratory illness that is spread through close contact between persons and respiratory transmissions and is highly contagious; and

WHEREAS, Kirksville, Missouri, has encountered conditions culminating in a public emergency, and a threat exists to the lives and property of the people of the City of Kirksville and issued an Emergency Proclamation on March 20, 2020; and

WHEREAS, an emergency continues to exist due to the impacts of the COVID-19 pandemic, curtailing the protection of the lives and property contained in Kirksville, Missouri; and

WHEREAS, Governor of Missouri Michael Parsons has extended a state of emergency for the state of Missouri until March 31, 2021.

NOW THEREFORE, I, Zac Burden, Mayor of the City of Kirksville, Missouri, hereby declare that a state of emergency continues to exists in Kirksville, Missouri, until March 31, 2021, and hereby invokes and declares in full force and effect in Kirksville, Missouri, all laws, statutes, of the State of Missouri, and Kirksville, for the exercise of all necessary emergency authority for the protection of the lives and property of the people of Kirksville, Missouri, and the restoration of local government with a minimum of interruption.

As pursuant with Chapter 44 of the Revised Missouri State Statutes, City Ordinances, and applicable Gubernatorial Executive Orders, as pertinent to:

All public offices and employees of Kirksville, Missouri, are hereby directed to exercise the utmost diligence in discharge of duties required of them for the duration of the emergency and in the execution of emergency laws, regulations, and directives state, and local.

All citizens are called upon and directed to comply with necessary emergency measures, to cooperate with public officials including the Adair County Health Department, and Kirksville, Missouri, Emergency Management forces in executing emergency operational plans, and to obey and comply with the lawful directions of properly identified public offices.
